Year F children currently in school:

The staff in school will take each bubble group out to meet their new teacher.

Year F children currently learning at home:

We would like to invite those children who have not yet returned to school to join a bubble group on a temporary basis, in order to meet their new teacher. Since each bubble cannot exceed 15 children, we have allocated these children to a group according to the space available. **We will text parents whose children have not returned to school with details of the temporary bubble group and time.**

If you are happy for your child to join us for this purpose, we ask that you bring your child to the parent car park, off Cornelius Drive, about 5 minutes before the meeting start time. There will be a member of staff waiting near the car park to escort the children to the meeting area. After 45 minutes, your child will be accompanied back to the car park area, ready for you to collect. If you would like to wait in your car, you are welcome to do so. The children do not need to wear school uniform.

We are approaching the end of a most unusual year, but looking forward to all the children returning in September. In the meantime, I wish all of your families well.
