Dear QI Parents and Carers,



I will be in a 'bubble' with other children and adults.


There will be some friends from my class and

adults that I already know.


It won't be a real bubble, but I will only be able to mix with those children in my 'bubble'.




There will be other children in their own 'bubbles'. I will try to stay 2 metres away from the other children and adults. How far is 2 metres?








I can wave 'hello!' to my friends...




... but I won't be able to give high fives and hugs.

Washing my hands












It will be helpful for you to practice washing your hands like this while you are at home, ready for when you come back to school.
