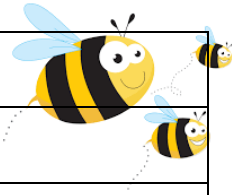

Please practise these words using the spelling strategies that we have shown you.

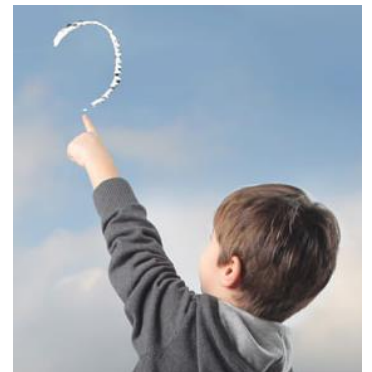

### Rules for adding -ly to a word:

1. Most words—just **add -ly**

soft → softly

2. If the root word ends in **-y**, change the **y** to an **i** and **add -ly**

happy → happily

3. If the root word ends in **-le**, change the **-le** to **-ly**

gentle → gently

4. If the root word ends in **-ic**, add **-ally**

magic → magically

5. If the root word ends in **-l**, add **-ly**

careful → carefully

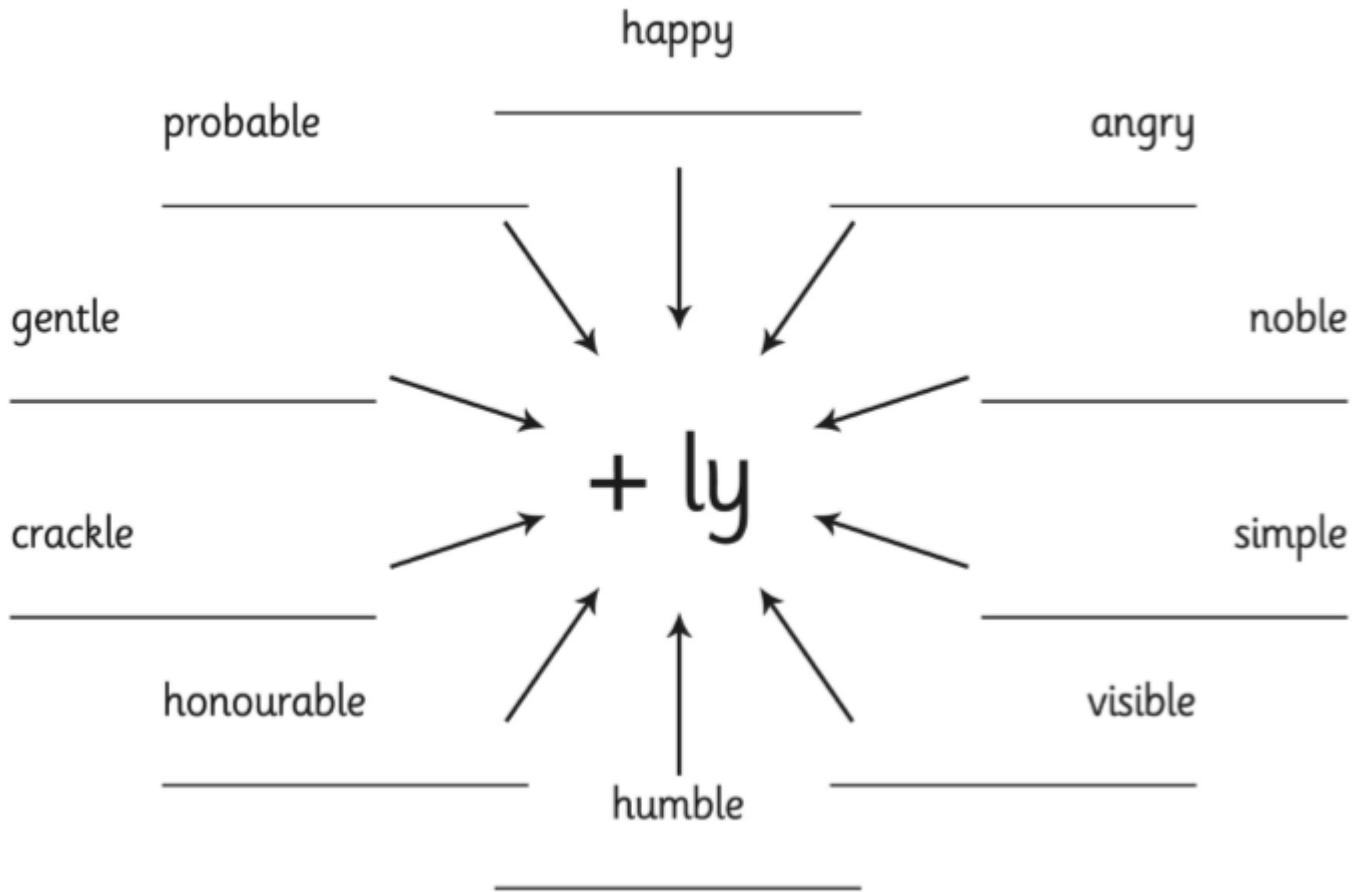
