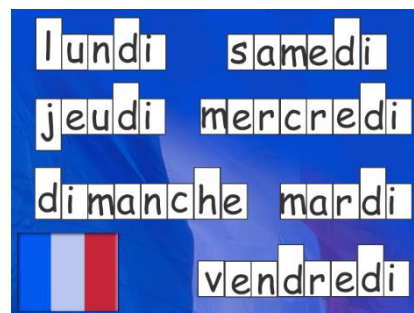
### Days of the Week
