

# Learning at Home for Year F 23rd to 27th March



## For our theme 'Farmyard Hullabaloo'

Go into the garden or look out of the window and look for:-

- 1. Signs of Spring- use a camera or tablet to take a photo
- 2. Parts of a plant- we have been labelling and observing the different parts of a plant. Can you dig up weeds at home and point to the different parts of the plant e.g. stem, roots, flower, bulb, leaves.

Try growing something from a seed - this could be an opportunity to grow a bean, cress or a sunflower.

Look for and learn about **Changes** - Are there any butterflies or caterpillars around? Have you seen a cocoon? Discuss the different life cycles you might be able to find or learn about.

#### Be creative

Spring Flower drawing - this week we have drawn daffodils and looked closely at the stem and flower. You could find a flower in the garden or a picture in a book and draw it (or paint it). Can you label the parts too?

Whole School Challenge – draw a self- portrait (or a portrait of someone else). We hope that you will bring these back into school to form a a whole-school or year group display when we se you again.

#### **Maths Workouts!**

Practise your number facts for 10 minutes a day e.g. pairs of numbers that make 10. Practise your calculating for 20 minutes a day- a Whole/Part/Part sheet has been provided for you to practice adding/taking away/doubling/halving. I will upload a video to Tapestry to model how to use this at home.

Phonics - please practice your phonics every day. If your child's phonic's teacher is:-

- 1. **Mr Young/Mr Saxton p**ractice:- j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, sh, th, ng. Vowel digraphs and trigraphs: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.
  - Please make any 'real' words using these sounds e.g. church or 'alien' words e.g. showp Use the website 'Phonics Play' to support this

- 2. **Miss Vince/Mr Browning practice**:- bl, br, cl, cr, dr, fl, fr, gl, gr, pl, pr, sc, scr, shr, sk, sl, tr, tw, st, str, sw, thr, sm, sn, sp, spl.
- 3. **Mrs Haddington**:- recap the initial sounds e.g. c, a, t, p and then practice j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, sh, th, ng. Vowel digraphs and trigraphs: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.
  - Please make any 'real' words using these sounds e.g. church or 'alien' words e.g. showp Use the website 'Phonics Play' to support this
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Handwriting – In your pack is a copy of the letter formation sheets. It would be brilliant if you practiced forming your letters whilst at home.
