Message from our Child and Family Support Worker

Our new Child & Family Support Worker – Carla Farrell, has felt very welcomed by the families she has met so far. She will be including a section in our newsletters on a specific topic which we hope will be both informative and helpful. This month, it's all about routine.

Starting school can be overwhelming for some children, especially new starters and those coming back after 6 weeks of summer holiday! Here at QI, we encourage all families to have a healthy and consistent routine for your children to support their transition from home to school. Just like adults, children feel more confident and secure when their daily activities are predictable and familiar.

A visual schedule sets out a daily routine for children in a way that is easy to understand. They're particularly popular with those who care for children with additional needs. Having them printed out or made as cards will allow your child to physically engage with them and hopefully feel a little more independent by using them. If you can find the time to create a routine board with your child it may help them take real ownership over it which may in turn be easier for you to implement.
