Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to be able to offer all Year 4 learners a day trip to Stubbington Study Centre on <u>Friday</u> <u>29th April 2022.</u> This year, parents will not be asked for a contribution to the cost.

Due to the requirements of the Year 4 curriculum, we will not be offering a residential trip. Instead, we hope to maximise the opportunities that Stubbington Study Centre offer to enhance our Geography and Science learning.

Activities of the day will include:

- A Locality Study to study the beach and Lee-on-the-Solent environment and the living things found in this bio-diverse habitat
- Pond dipping, which will also enhance our skills so we can continue this over the half term back at school
- Wildlife observation with the opportunity to observe the behaviours of living things in their natural habitat and to collect evidence that helps us identify them

We will be leaving school at **9:00am** and will arrive back at approximately **3:30pm**. We politely request that you **do not arrive on site before 3:30pm** as this will help avoid unnecessary congestion in the car park as the coach returns. We ask that your child wears their green school QI jumper/cardigan and a white polo/shirt as normal on the day of the trip. As the British weather can be unpredictable, we ask that your child is appropriately dressed for the trip. Below are kit lists for both eventualities.

Everyone Needs:

- Waterproof shoes
- Jumper/ hoody as the temperature may change next to the coast
- Covered legs leggings, tracksuit bottoms NOT JEANS
- A small bag to keep their belongings in backpack or similar
- A named water bottle
- A drink to have with their lunch no fizzy drinks or glass bottles

If Wet Weather	If Warm/Sunny Weather
Wellies instead of waterproof shoes	Sun cream
Waterproof coat	Sun hat

Your child will also need to bring their own packed lunch with them and plenty to drink (without sweets or fizzy drinks, as always). If your child is entitled to a free school meal and would like a packed lunch provided by the school, please contact the office by **Tuesday 26th April 2022**. The free school meal that we are offering is: a ham or cheese sandwich, crackers and Dairylea, carrot batons, red pepper slices, an apple and a shortbread biscuit.
