



Q1 Christmas Present Buying Day Friday 11th December 2020

Our annual Present Buying Day offers our children the chance to spend time thinking about others and choosing small Christmas gifts for their family and pets (not for themselves).

However, the plans this year are slightly different. Due to COVID-19 we are having to reduce the number of PTA members available to support your children and as a result we are offering an outdoor Present Buying Market exclusively to our Year 6 learners. This is to ensure they enjoy the magic of Present Buying Day in their final year at Q1.

The PTA will be stationed outside the Year 6 classrooms. We ask that, this year, the children focus on their immediate family with whom they live. The gifts on sale will cost up to a maximum of £2.50 each, with most costing around £1, and some at 50p. We ask that children bring in change and avoid notes.

Sadly, this year, we cannot facilitate the wrapping of presents in school and your child will bring their gifts home to wrap and put under the Christmas tree.

All children who wish to participate should bring to school on Friday 11th December:

- Money in a named purse – enough for the number of presents that they are buying.
- A strong carrier bag with your child's name on it.
- A shopping list of who they want to buy for (optional).

If a child forgets to bring money, they will need to see their teacher before going into the hall so that arrangements can be made for late payment. Please note that presents will not be able to go home until payment has been received.

If you do not wish your child to participate in Present Buying Day, please let your child's class teacher know.
