#### Christmas at QI 2025

# <u>Christmas Cards – Monday 8<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> December</u>



Children within the same year group are welcome to exchange Christmas cards between them, but not across the wider school. Please understand that we cannot give the names of children out to parents. Once again, we will provide an alternative to sending out cards, so each class will have a designated message board for the children to write their own Christmas message to their peers, rather than send individual cards.

## <u>Christmas Jumper Day – Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December</u>

All children are invited to wear a Christmas Jumper to school on Present Buying Day. Although the official UK Save the Children Christmas Jumper Day is the day before, we prefer to align ours with Present Buying Day. If you wish to donate, please do so directly to **Save The Children**.



#### Present Buying Day - Friday 12th December

Our wonderful PTA are hosting our annual Present Buying Day in the hall. This event offers children the chance to spend time thinking about others and choosing small Christmas gifts for their family and pets (though not for themselves). All gifts will range between 50p and £2.50. On the day, please provide for your child:

- A strong carrier bag with your child's name on it.
- Money in a named purse enough for the number of presents that they are buying.
- 3m roll of wrapping paper
- Sellotape
- Labels (pre-written for the younger children please).

#### Years 1 and 2 'Knock Knock' The Nativity – Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> December

Our annual Christmas Service of readings and songs will be held at Waterlooville Baptist Church (368 London Rd, Waterlooville PO7 7SY). The doors will open at 10:00am for a 10:15am start - the service will last approximately 30 minutes. We would be most grateful if, wherever possible, parents could walk to the church as there is only limited parking available. Seats are limited to 2 per family as we may only have the use of the ground floor this year. Please be aware that photography and recordings are not be permitted in this place of worship.
